UPDATE ON COURTS

TENNIS COURT #6 WORKING GROUP UPDATE

Last year, the Board appointed a working group to explore options for the best use of Tennis Court #6, particularly whether the court could be converted to create additional pickleball courts. The group also considered whether other sports courts could be used to create additional pickleball court space in the near term. On April 25, the working group presented their recommendations to the Board of Directors. The group reported that converting any of the existing tennis or basketball courts would negatively impact neighboring homes, reduce the enjoyment of other nearby amenities and take away amenities enjoyed by residents. At the April meeting, the Board agreed with the working group's recommendation and voted to leave all sports courts, including tennis court #6, as-is.



LIVING WITH WILDLIFE

This week, a bobcat was discovered in a resident's yard, and the Arizona

Game and Fish Department euthanized it as a precautionary measure.

Living in Las Sendas, we are fortunate to be surrounded by a natural environment that is home to various forms of wildlife.

Remembering and practicing caution and respect when encountering these creatures is essential.

The Arizona Game and Fish Department recommends you contact them at 623-236-7201 if you encounter animals that appear ill or exhibit aggressive behavior towards humans. If you notice wildlife simply passing through and behaving normally, Arizona Game and Fish recommends deterring them from the area by making noise or using other non-harmful methods.
